## **Supporting Information**

### 1. Background

- 1.1 The Executive considered the Park Way Development Brief at its May meeting (Item 13 refers). The Newbury Town Centre Task Group previously considered the draft.
- 1.2 Paragraph 4.3.1 of the Development Brief covers the issue of archaeology. The paragraph states:
  - "There are no Scheduled Monuments within the proposed development area. There are no known archaeological sites or finds within the site. However, a desktop assessment carried out in 2000 by Oxford Archaeological Unit concluded that the Park Way area has the potential to contain archaeology from all periods and that there is also a high potential for waterlogged deposits. A watching brief will therefore be required by the Council to monitor excavation works during the development period."
- 1.3 The Newbury Town Centre Task Group has now reconsidered this final sentence and considers a more robust approach is required. As a result they are recommending that the Executive replace this final sentence with the following:
  - "In line with Government guidance, local plan policy and the Park Way Planning Brief, the site should be subject to detailed archaeological field evaluation by the developer. Subject to the results of this work a programme of mitigation will be drawn up that may include preservation in-situ and/or a programme of archaeological investigation, recording and publication."
- 1.4 The Task Group ask the Executive to approve the amendment for inclusion in the Development Brief.
