

# Summary of Purley Experimental One Way Order Decision(s) taken on 30 June 2011

## Part I

### Purley Experimental One Way Order (Item 1.)

**Individual Decision No:** ID2298

**Portfolio Member:** Councillor Graham Jones (Leader of the Council)

Resolved that:

- 1) The Purley experimental one way system is not made permanent.
- 2) A 20mph speed limit be considered for Purley Lane and Purley Village as part of the Speed Limit Review meeting in December 2011.
- 3) A Traffic Management Assessment is programmed during 2012/13 to investigate the concerns of the residents of Nursery Gardens.
- 4) Comments about parking issues be included within the Purley parking review that is currently being undertaken.
- 5) The respondents who formally objected and responded to the public consultation be informed accordingly.
