NOTICE OF DECISION

The Licensing Sub-Committee of West Berkshire Council met on **23rd January 2013** and resolved to approve **Application 12/02019/LQN** submitted by Leisure Licence Ltd for a variation to a Premises Licence number 016230 issued in respect of premises known as **Document House, 7-9 Wharf Street Newbury, Newbury RG14 5AN** subject to a number of conditions.

In coming to their decision, the Sub-Committee had regard to the four licensing objectives, which are:
