### **Supporting Information**

### 1. Background

- 1.1 West Berkshire Council's Forward Plan, which is published monthly, sets out the key decisions that the Executive (either collectively or by Individual Executive Members) are expected to take over the next four months.
- 1.2 Key decisions are defined by the Government (Regulation 8 of the Local Authorities (Executive Arrangements)(Access to Information)(England) Regulations 2001) as:
  - (1) Those which result in the Local Authority incurring expenditure which is, or the making of savings which are, significant having regard to the Local Authority's budget for the service or function to which the decision is related.
  - (2) Those which are significant in terms of its effect on communities living or working in an area comprising two or more wards or electoral divisions in the area of the Local Authority.
- 1.3 The introduction of The Local Authorities (Executive Arrangements) (Meetings and Access to Information) (England) Regulations 2012 in September 2012 included a requirement to publish 28 clear days' notice of any intended key decision. It should be noted that "clear days" means working days, from midnight to midnight, and excludes weekends and public holidays, so 28 clear days equates to around 5½ normal weeks.
- 1.4 On occasions, however, situations may arise where an urgent decision needs to be made in respect of an item that does not appear on the Forward Plan. There are two different ways in which this can be done:
  - (i) the authority can take an urgent key decision without giving 28 days' notice where it is impracticable to give the full notice, provided that the authority gives at least five days' clear notice to all Members of the Overview and Scrutiny Management Commission, which can then call in the decision to check that it was genuinely urgent; or
  - (ii) where a key decision is so urgent there is not even time to give five clear days' notice, the authority can take the decision if the Chairman of the Overview and Scrutiny Management Commission has agreed that the key decision is urgent and cannot reasonably be deferred.
- 1.5 In addition The Local Authorities (Executive Arrangements) (Meetings and Access to Information) (England) Regulations 2012 have introduced an entirely new requirement for the Council to publish 28 clear days' notice of the intention to hold a private meeting (or part of a meeting) of the Executive. This 28 day notice must be reinforced by a five day notice which sets out the reasons for the meeting to be held in private, details of any propositions received as to why the meeting should be open, and the Council's response. The response will be provided by the Monitoring Officer. The regulations again provide for an urgency procedure, under which the Council can decide the matter with shorter than 28 or five days' notice, provided that it has first obtained the consent of the Chairman of the Overview and Scrutiny Management Commission.

- 1.6 There are currently four confidential items scheduled for the 18 December 2014 Executive meeting and the required notice is attached as an appendix and will be displayed at the Council. If any representations are received the five day notice will be issued on 10 December 2014. The items are:
  - Staffing Implications associated with savings put forward to deliver the 2015/16 revenue budget: approval to pay redundancy payments (EX2883)
  - Progress on Sexual Health Procurement and request for delegated authority to Strategic Director of Public Health for approving final provider of services (EX2918)
  - Alcohol and Drug Recovery Service Tender (EX2924)
  - Royal Berkshire Fire and Rescue Service Provision of Committee Service (EX2910)
- 1.7 The following items have been added to/deleted from the Forward Plan for the December 2014 Executive meeting or Individual Decision in December, since it was last published:

- 1.8 Details of decisions that Full Council, the Governance and Audit Committee and the Personnel Committee are going to take are also included for ease of reference. It should, however, be noted that the new requirements only apply to Executive meetings.
- 1.9 Publication of the Forward Plan remains a statutory requirement of the Local Authority. The Forward Plan, any General Exception Decisions Notices and Notices of Private Decisions have to be available for inspection and also have to be published on the Council's website.

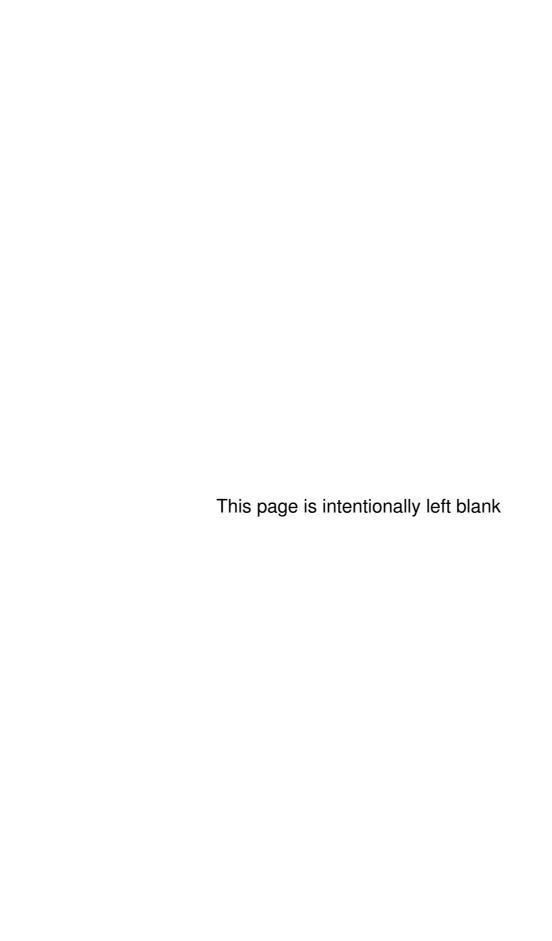

At least 5 clear days before a private meeting of a decision-making body, further public notice<sup>4</sup> must be given which must include a statement of reasons for the meeting to be held in private, details of any representations received by the decision-making body about why the meeting should be open to the public and a statement of the Council's response to such representations.
- 3. Where the date by which a meeting must be held makes compliance with the above requirements impracticable, the meeting may only be held in private where the decision-making body has obtained agreement from the Chair of the Overview and Scrutiny Management Commission.
- 4. Compliance with the requirements for the giving of public notice has been impracticable in relation to the business detailed below.
