#### **1 Purpose of the Report**

1.1 To approve the final school funding formula allocations for 2021/22.

#### 2 **Recommendations**

- 2.1 To approve that the 2021/22 school funding formula be allocated to schools.
- 2.2 To note that the Authority Proforma Tool (APT) was submitted to the DfE on 21 January 2021 based on the 0.25% approved transfer to the High Needs Block, and was resubmitted on 25 January 2021 to reflect the 0.5% transfer.
- 2.3 To note that the final formula rates and allocations to schools will be allocated to schools by 28<sup>th</sup> February 2021.

#### 4 **Executive Summary**

- 4.1 2021/22 is the fourth year of the National Funding Formula (NFF). As in previous years, the Local Authority (LA) continues to have discretion over their schools funding formulae, in consultation with local schools. The LA is responsible for making the final decisions on the formula. Political ratification is required for the LA to be able to issue budgets to maintained schools before the 28<sup>th</sup> February 2021.
- 4.2 A consultation was held with schools between 21.10.20 and 11.11.20. Responses were considered by the Schools Forum and a methodology for allocating the funding was agreed, including approval to transfer 0.25% of school funding to the High Needs block.
- 4.3 Final DSG allocations were received from the Department for Education (DfE) in December, which for schools totalled £114.83m including growth funding of £0.6m. Due to the cumulative balance on the growth fund being sufficient, it was agreed at Schools Forum on 26.1.21 to allocate the growth fund to schools via the formula, and to increase the transfer to the High Needs block to the maximum of 0.5%.

#### **5** Supporting Information

#### Introduction

- 5.1 2021/22 is the fourth year of the National Funding Formula (NFF). As in previous years, the Local Authority (LA) continues to have discretion over their schools funding formulae, in consultation with local schools. The LA is responsible for making the final decisions on the formula. Political ratification is required for the LA to be able to issue budgets to maintained schools before the 28<sup>th</sup> February 2021.
- 5.2 A consultation was held between 21.10.20 and 11.11.20. The responses were considered by the Schools Forum in December 2020, and the following agreed:
  - (a) To mirror the DfE's 2021/22 National Funding Formula
  - (b) To award a lower increase to the schools sparsity factor in the local formula
  - (c) To address any surplus or shortfall in funding by adjusting the AWPU values
  - (d) To apply a 0.25% top slice of the schools' funding, in order to support High Needs
  - (e) To approve the criteria for additional funds as per the consultation
  - (f) To approve the proposed de-delegations.
- 5.3 Final DSG allocations were received in December from the DfE totalling £114.83m, including growth funding of £0.6m. At the Schools Forum of 25 January 2021 it was agreed not to increase the growth fund and to allocate the 2021/22 growth funding via the formula and to increase the top slice of schools' funding from 0.25% to 0.5%, in order to support High Needs.

#### **Growth Funding 2021/22**

- 5.4 The main DSG funding for schools is lagged and based on pupil numbers from the previous October census. Since 2019/20, growth funding is allocated to the local authority by formula and forms part of the Schools Block DSG. The formula for allocating growth funding to each LA is based on actual growth in pupil numbers.
- 5.5 As it is within the schools block, a movement of funding between the schools formula and the growth fund is not treated as a transfer between blocks. If funding is not required for growth, it can be added into the school formula, but if there is a shortfall, this needs to be met from a top slice of the main schools' block allocation.
- 5.6 The cumulative balance on the growth fund was £666k at 31.3.2020. The 2020/21 DSG growth allocation of £756k was all put aside for growth, but with an estimated spend of £150k, the fund could total £1.27m by 31.3.2021.

5.7 The DSG growth allocation for 2021/22 is £604k. The projected balance of the growth fund is sufficient, so it was agreed to use £274k of the 2021/22 growth allocation to increase the High Needs Block transfer from 0.25% as previously agreed, to 0.5%, and put the balance of £330k into the school formula and allocate to schools. The HNB additional funding would be on a spend to save basis supporting initiatives that will support the block to reduce its annual expenditure over time.

#### Final School Funding

5.8 The final schools block DSG funding allocation for 2021/22 is £114.83m, and after the 0.5% HNB transfer of £0.549m, there is £114.28m available for schools.
