# **Schools Funding Formula 2022/23**

### 1 Purpose of the Report

1.1 To approve the school funding formula distribution for 2022/23.

#### 2 Recommendations

- 2.1 To approve the 2022/23 school funding formula to be distributed to schools. The allocations have been made according to the principles agreed by Schools' Forum in December and in relation to the total funding available from the Schools Block DSG.
- 2.2 To note that the Authority Proforma Tool (APT) was submitted to the Department for Education (DfE) on 21 January 2022 based on the 0.25% approved transfer to the High Needs Block.
- 2.3 To note that the final formula rates and allocations will be notified to schools by 28<sup>th</sup> February 2021.

### 4 Executive Summary

- 4.1 2022/23 is the fifth year of the National Funding Formula (NFF). As in previous years, the Local Authority (LA) continues to have discretion over their schools funding formulae, in consultation with local schools. The LA is responsible for making the final decisions on the formula. Political ratification is required for the LA to be able to issue budgets to maintained schools before the 28th February 2022.
- 4.2 A consultation was held with schools between 20.10.21 and 10.11.21. Responses were considered by the Schools Forum and a methodology for distributing the funding was agreed, including approval to transfer 0.25% of school funding to the High Needs block.
  - 4.3 The final DSG funding notification of £118.5m was received from the DfE in December, including a growth allocation of £0.87m. The funding distribution to schools includes a further £1.57m for Business Rates, and a deduction of £0.3m for the High Needs Block transfer. The growth allocation will be distributed as part of the formula and not added to the Growth Fund. Total allocation to schools is £119.8m.

## **5** Supporting Information

#### Introduction

- 5.1 A consultation with schools on the schools' funding formula was held between 20.10.21 and 10.11.21. The responses were considered by the Schools Forum in December 2021, and the following agreed:
  - (a) To mirror the Department for Education's (DfE) 2022/23 National Funding Formula (NFF) to calculate the funding allocations.
  - (b) To use a reduced sparsity factor, set at 80% of the NFF values.
  - (c) To address any surplus or shortfall in funding by adjusting the AWPU values.
  - (d) To apply a 0.25% top slice to the schools' funding.
  - (e) To use the block transfer to support the High Needs Block including support for Early Years development and capacity.
  - (f) To adopt the criteria to be used to allocate additional funds.
  - (g) To distribute the 2022/23 growth allocation as part of the funding formula.
- 5.2 At the Schools Forum in December 2021 it was agreed not to increase the Growth Fund but to distribute the 2022/23 growth allocation via the formula.

5.3 The final DSG funding notification was received from the DfE in December 2021 totalling £118.5m, including a growth allocation of £0.87m. The funding distribution to schools includes a further £1.57m for Business Rates, and a deduction of £0.3m for the High Needs Block transfer. The growth allocation will be distributed as part of the formula and not added to the Growth Fund. Total allocation to schools is £119.8m.

#### **Growth Funding 2022/23**

- 5.4 The main DSG funding for schools is lagged and based on pupil numbers from the previous October census. Since 2019/20, growth funding is allocated to the local authority by formula and forms part of the Schools Block DSG. The formula for allocating growth funding to each LA is based on actual growth in pupil numbers.
- 5.5 This funding can be put aside into a Growth Fund, where it can be awarded to schools under certain criteria. If not required for growth, it can be added into the school formula, but if there is a shortfall, this needs to be met from a top slice of the main schools' block allocation. As it is within the schools block, a movement of funding between the schools formula and the Growth Fund is not treated as a transfer between blocks.
- 5.6 The cumulative balance on our Growth Fund was £1.5m at 31.3.2021 and is forecast to be £1.1m by 31.3.2022. The DSG growth funding for 2022/23 is £875k. The projected balance of our Growth Fund is sufficient, so the Schools' Forum agreed to put all the 2022/23 funding into the school formula to distribute to schools.
