Subject:	RIPA (Regulatory of Investigatory Powers Act) Policy	
Decision taken:	Authority be delegated to the Head of PPP to approve the RIPA policy under paragraph 3.15.1 of the Council's Constitution.	
Reason for decision taken:	To ensure that the authority has a fit for purpose policy in place. The RIPA Policy has not been reviewed since implementation in April 2010 and required updating.	
Other options considered:	None – It is a statutory requirement for a Local Authority to have in place a policy as regards RIPA. The policy has been updated to take account of all current codes of practice, IPCO guidance and any feedback from IPCO audit findings.	
	Covert directed surveillance forms an intrinsic part of certain types of investigation and there are times when the only way vital evidence can be secured is through this route. Article 8 of the European Convention on Human Rights sets out the principle of the 'right to privacy. The purpose of RIPA is to provide a framework under which specified public bodies may carry out directed surveillance in a highly controlled and regulated manner. Without this statutory exemption the use of surveillance could give rise to a claim for breach of Human Rights legislation.	
	Surveillance powers can only be accessed by local authorities for the purpose of 'prevention and detection of crime and the prevention of disorder' and are subject to both internal oversight through specifically trained authorising officers and then ultimately judicial oversight by the Magistrates Court.
