## **Supporting Information**

### 1. Background

- 1.1 The Council is required to appoint representatives to a range of Outside Bodies. The bulk of these appointments were made on the 02 June 2011 following the local elections. A number of changes to the appointments were made in May 2014. In reviewing those appointments Members became aware of three additional changes that they wished to make:
  - Officers were notified that Bob Morgan had resigned as the Council's representative on 14 21 and needed to be replaced;
  - Councillor Gwen Mason wanted to step down from the Foster Carers Panel due to work commitments and it was proposed that Councillor David Allen replace her;
  - It was proposed that Councillor Adrian Edwards replace Councillor Hilary Cole on the Berkshire Historic Environment Forum as he was the Council's Heritage Champion.
- 1.2 Appointments will be made in accordance with Appendix J to part 13 of The Constitution (Protocol for Council representatives on Outside Bodies).

#### 2. 14-21

- 2.1 The organisation provides support to young people in the 14-21 age group in addressing and counselling them in relation to issues and concerns creating difficulties in their lives. The Council is required to appoint two trustees with no voting rights or legal responsibilities. One of the Council's representatives, Bob Morgan, had resigned and needed to be replaced.
- 2.2 To date no Councillors have expressed an interest in replacing Bob Morgan.

#### 3. Foster Carers Panel

- 3.1 The organisation is a Statutory Panel responsible for scrutinising and approving the assessments, reviews and placements of looked after children.
- 3.2 Councillor David Allen has expressed an interest in replacing Councillor Mason.

#### 4. Berkshire Historic Environment Forum

- 4.1 The organisation shares knowledge and concerns about Berkshire's Historic environment by encouraging co-operation between individuals, organisations and promoting the environment to the public.
- 4.2 Councillor Hilary Cole, the Council's current representative on the forum has suggested that it might be more appropriate for the Council's Heritage Champion (Councillor Adrian Edwards) to replace her on this organisation. Councillor Edwards has agreed to take up the appointment if the Leader was minded to agree it.
