- 1. Alcohol will only be sold or supplied with menu based food for home delivery, **ONLY!**
- 2. All incidents which impact on any of the four licensing objectives shall be recorded in a register kept at the premises for this purpose. The names of the person recording the information and those members of staff who deal with any incident shall also be recorded. Where known, any offenders name shall also be recorded.
- 3. The Premises Licence Holder or Designated Premises Licence Holder shall ensure staffs receive training on a regular basis, every four months, in relation to the Four Licensing Objectives contained within the Licensing Act 2003 for those authorised to sell alcohol. Written proof of training shall be recorded and maintained.

b) The prevention of crime and disor

Alcohol will only be delivered to a residential address that has been given by the person placing the order.

c) Public safety

A challenge 25 policy will be in operation if the delivery driver considers the recipient of the alcohol to be under 25. A recognised photographic identification shall be requested before the alcohol is handed over.

d) The prevention of public nuisance

Management shall ensure that late night noise maturing from the premises shall be kept to an acceptable level.

e) The protection of children from harm

- 1. A challenge 25 policy will be in operation if the delivery driver considers the recipient of the alcohol to be under 25. A recognised photographic identification shall be requested before the alcohol is handed over.
- 2. Whenever alcohol is delivered to the purchaser, it shall only be delivered to a residential address or business address. The receiver of the alcohol must be able to prove to the person delivering the alcohol they are a resident or employee at the premises and must be inside the building or at the doorway of the business, house or flat.
- 3. All persons delivering alcohol must be aged 18 or over.
