- No evidence of how to prevent under age sales (Protection of Young People)
- No evidence of training to be provided to staff (Protection of Young People)
- No evidence of the type of transport used to deliver alcohol (Driver's and Public Safety)
- No evidence of responsible retailing i.e. what procedures would be in place should a delivery driver identify the purchaser(s) are already intoxicated to an unsafe level (Business Liability and Public Safety)
- The hours of sales to be reduced to 11.00 – 23.00 (Responsible Retailing)
