1. Introduction

1.1 1.1 The Crisis Care Concordat is a shared agreed statement, based on a national initiative, signed by senior representatives from all the organisations involved across the whole of Berkshire. It covers what needs to happen when people in mental health crisis need help – in policy making and spending decisions, in anticipating and preventing mental health crises wherever possible, and in making sure effective emergency response systems operate in localities when a crisis does occur
