


**The Prevention of Crime and Disorder:** Increasing the licensing hours of the golf club will encourage more inebriated guests to wander down the roads in a rowdy and disruptive manner. Only a few weeks ago a group came by and caused much disruption in the lane leading to Lough Down, defacing the National Trust signs and posters and alarming the cattle.

**The Prevention of Public Nuisance:** would exacerbate all of the above. Late night functions will present an increase in noise levels as the functions run on later. We already see guests of the club/functions throw beer cans and other litter out of their car windows as they leave at night. This will only worsen if the application is successful.

**The Protection of Children from Harm:**

The main issue here is the increase in traffic this would cause with the increased number of potential functions such as weddings and parties.
