### 6. Introduction/Background

- 6.1 The Standing Advisory Council on Religious Education (SACRE) was established in accordance with Section 390 of the Education Act 1996 by West Berkshire District Council acting as the Local Education Authority.
- 6.2 The SACRE was established to set the RE syllabus, advise the Local Authority on matters connected with religious worship and advise on methods of teaching, the choice of materials used and the provision of training for teachers.

The standing Advisory Council on Religious Education comprises four groups each with a single vote to use when voting is necessary.

The four groups are:

Group A: Representatives of Christian denominations other than the Church of England and of other religions	Group B: Church of England representatives
Group C: Up to 6 Education Union representatives from the following Unions, with no more than 3 from any one union: NUT, NAS/UWT, ATL, PAT, NAHT,SHA	Group D Representatives of the local authority

6.3 The Local Authority is responsible for appointing members to each of these four groups. This is usually achieved by seeking nominations from each area. There is currently only one representative in Group C (Education Union representatives). In order to allow additional representatives to join the West Berkshire SACRE, the committee recently changed its constitution to allow up to three members per union group, as set out in the table above.

- 6.4 A nomination has been received for Ms Clare Nolan, Religious Education teacher at Little Heath School, currently a member of the NUT. If appointed, Ms Nolan would represent Group C on the West Berkshire SACRE. The nomination has been supported by the Local Stakeholders as set out in the consultation responses. As Ms Nolan is a new member of the NUT then it has not been possible to obtain a letter of support from the union. Following consultation no objections were received to this nomination.
