Victim was assaulted by an unknown male whilst dancing with some girls on the dancefloor. Victim was knocked onto the ground and door staff and friends have dragged suspect off. Suspect has then been ejected from the club by doorstaff whilst they have checked that victim is in order. Suspect has left premises without police attendance and he is currently identified.

Staff did apparently step in to stop the suspect assaulting the victim, they have then ejected the suspect and checked on the victims welfare. However staff have failed to detain the suspect, they have failed to alert police to the incident occurring despite there being police presence through nightsafe operation. Door staff have not alerted police to any part of this assault - victim has reported the assault to police 3 days later.

They produced a USB stick version initially however this was corrupt and not playable. Police have then reattended a couple of times but staff were unable to produce CCTV onto a disc or USB - sometimes stating that manager was not in, but OIC did not get a reply when contact details where left asking for a call.

Female aggrieved has been ejected from the Vault nightclub around 23:00hrs by door staff together with a friend who then tried to get her a taxi but she then refused to get in. Venue staff had served female approximately 250ml of vodka and five Sambuca shots within the space of 1.5 hours leaving her unable to stand on her own. She has then gone to the bus stop opposite the nightclub and lay down on the bench. The next thing she remembers is then being driven in a vehicle and she was in the seat behind the driver. When the vehicle has stopped she has open the sliding door and exited and tried to run away. The offender has then got out of the car and has pulled her back by the straps of her clothing into the back seat of the vehicle. She then remembers he offender saying in a strong Indian accent "Do you like that." She can then remember the offender penetrating her vagina with his fingers and then believes he had sexual intercourse with her.

Manager of venue and doorstaff when approached by police have assisted them in their initial enquiries by firstly identifying the friend of the aggrieved and secondly viewing CCTV throughout the nightclub identifying relevant times of events.

Police have taken statements from aggrieved and witness and arranged for SARC medical. Ongoing enquiries and lines of investigation by Force CID.

Condition 1 - This condition was not complied with and no written policy for searching was available to be seen. It was stated at the time of the inspection that it was in the process of being produced but no evidence was supplied to support that statement.

Finally, we discussed our concerns with the current queue management systems and lack of general record keeping and extremely poor licensing administration which has led to the serious failures in relation to your licence condition compliance.

You are reminded that the people legally responsible for the premises under the Licensing Act 2003 are the premises licence holder and the designated premises supervisor.

With that in mind a performance meeting will be arranged to enable us to rectify our concerns over your non-compliance with your licence conditions, and overall general poor performance to date.

It is hoped that you will be able to provide sufficient evidence at this stage to show the required improvements that may negate further action.

We must inform you that this will be a formal process and you may wish to have a licensing legal advisor attend to provide you with advice if you feel that may be required.

You will be contacted in due course and provided the date and venue of the performance meeting.

In the meantime can you please ensure that all of the above points contained within this letter have been rectified, and an unannounced inspection during trading hours will be completed in the very near future to ensure that your licence is now in compliance and that your premises does not continue to undermine the licensing objectives

Door staff stated that they had been made aware of an assault on the dance floor and that they had ejected a number of persons and that they had taken the female caller to one side.

Officers spoke with her who stated that her boyfriend had been punched in the face on the dance floor by a known offender and that she had reported this to door staff. She had left the club to call Police.

As PC Hubbard-Clark was talking with the caller of this report PC 1449 DRUMMOND and PC 1442 BURFORD needed assistance with the male they had now arrested for another assault in the night club.

It took three officers to take this male to custody due to limited number of officers in the town that night it left no other units to cover the town.

The door staff of the Vault stated that they would look after the female caller to Police untill the Officers could relatend.

Once Officers had returned to the night club the boyfriend of the female was spoken to who had no injury and an appointment book in the morning to see victim and caller. (The appointment was attended by the victim and caller and no complaint was made and crime report filed.)

Offender had left the area after being taken out by door staff.

It was a very busy Saturday night for the vault with large number of persons within the night and outside. They dealt with both incidents well and used the shop safe radios when needed.

There does seem to be issues with getting information on what is happening inside the club to the door staff on the doors when officers arrive.

Due to the smoking area being just outside the entrance doors and the que down the side of the night club you are confronted with large groups of people and it can be hard to separate incidents from persons outside the night club.



Door staff dealt with both incidents well and tried their best to separate all persons from both incidents. Used the shop safe radios when needed. A very busy Saturday.

There are issues with getting information on what happended in the club from staff in the Vault to the staff on the doors. This is in my view due to how busy they are and the size of club not from them being unwilling to give information. The smoking area out the front of the Vault is an issue when trying to deal with incidents as it causes a large amount of on lookers and perons trying to get involved and can be hard to separate perons from offenders, witnesses and votims.

Shop safe radios are outdated and will drop out of signal.

Call on the nightsafe radio, DS had been assaulted at venue and male detained on the floor.

Male was ejected and then attempted to get back in. DS ushered him away as he tried to push past them. The suspect punched the DS in the face and was then taken too and restrained on the floor. When police arrived, the DS let the male up who promptly kicked off and they struggled to get him down again.

All police were committed at the time, but attended within 3-4 minutes. On arrival the DS on the male let him up which caused further disorder. He was difficult to subdue and Captor was used. DS were spoken too about letting the male up again whilst they had control of him. Victim provided a statement and suspect was cautioned following interview. CCTV was inadequate. The camera on the side of the building which covers the queue and would likely have captured some of the incident, was not working. The camera inside the front door does not cover anything outside. The camera that covers the smoking area, only covers the smoking area, and not the front door. There was no footage available outside the front of the venue. The DPS, Andy, stated that he was concerned around the camera covering the smoking area covering too much in to public space!!!! He was advised that the CCTV would expected to cover the working area of his staff, which included the front door, outside. He was told that the faults needed to be rectified by Thursday when they are due to open next.

The Vault held a boxing event, there was a large group outside at around 2100 hours on 02/02/2019. Later the same evening Walkabout informed officers that The Vault had issue with getting a group to leave. Some of the boxers and supporters went onto Walkabout. Just after midnight Walkabout called for assistance as they were ejecting a group of around 20 who had been at the boxing and were now in their venue. A large group remained outside until officers dispersed them. This was URN 12 03/02/2019. At 03:10 hours another 2 were ejected and related to the boxing event earlier, this is URN 208 03/02/2019.

At 0406 police are then called to reports of a domestic and a criminal damage at the Premier Inn, Town Centre, callers reports that they have been at the boxing match. It was requested a taser trained officer attended due to knowledge of the males that had previously been ejected from Walkabout.

Walkabout removed them when they became and issue and informed police of their behaviour.

Premier inn took positive action, called police, reported a possible domestic assault.

No information as to whether The Vault have assisted the police in anyway.

Multiple different officers have attended the various incidents, including ICT and NHPT officers, most were dispersed into taxis, 1 male arrested for domestic offences and criminal damage at the premier inn.

This is not the first time a boxing event at The Vault has resulted in a large amount of police resources being deployed

to incidents resulting in arrests.

On Saturday 9th February 2019 PC 5110 Allen visited your premises to ensure you are complying with the above premises licence.

During this visit PC Allen was assisted by the Designated Premises Supervisor (DPS) Mr Robert Anderson.

During this inspection, PC Allen found a number of items and breaches of the licence conditions that require rectification.

Below outlines the breaches of conditions:-

Conditions agreed with Thames Valley Police (12/12/2017)

Prevention of crime and disorder page 8

Admission Policies ID Scan

Condition 1 (a) (b) and (c) – The ID SCAN was not on 45 minutes after opening and it was identified that it was not working. When asked when he had reported this as the license prescribes Mr Anderson stated he is reporting it now to the inspecting officer. Mr Anderson also stated it has been problematic and only keeps the details for 7 days not 31 days as the license prescribes. Having spoken to a former door supervisor who stopped working at the Vault before Christmas 2018 she had never seen the ID SCAN working. It appears to have been faulty for a long time and has not been reported immediately to Thames Valley Police as the license prescribes neither has it been remedied as soon as practicable as prescribed in on the license (Page 9).

Prevention of crime and disorder page 9

Search policy

Condition 2 - This condition was not complied with as the notices advertising the correct information was not displayed. The notice should clearly demonstrate that the right is reserved as a condition of entry and Thames Valley Police shall be informed if anyone is found to be in possession of Drugs or Offensive weapons. It would be prudent to include condition 1(a) that 100% of customers after 2200 hours will be searched on the notice.

Prevention of crime and disorder page 10

Radio System

The condition is not compiled with as The Vault is no longer a member of the Shop Safe scheme and their radio has been returned to the BID who manage the scheme. Mr Anderson states this is due to an over charging matter where he was charged as a larger organisation when he joined the scheme but then recently went down to a lower tariff. All of these charges were made clear at the time but failing to pay has resulted in the breach.

Pubwatch

The condition is not complied with as The Vault has not complied with the requirements of Pubwatch and their authority to access DISC prohibited. There in no way for them to now check to see if patrols are in fact on the Pubwatch banned list.

CCTV

This condition was not complied with, the CCTV systems recorded images are not of such quality to identify persons in any light and the entire licensable area is not covered. It was identified that not all parts of the licensable area were covered by the cctv system.

A section 19 closure notice was issued in relation to this breach for the system to be improved to a standard that is compliant with your licence condition. A period of 21 days was given to improve the system as Mr Anderson suggested that would provide suitable time to make the required changes.

Please be aware that this will be re-inspected and it is imperative that your undertaking to upgrade the system is completed. This was also identified in January 2018 following a similar inspection.

Event plans

Condition 2A – This condition was not complied with; as you utilised an external promoter to organise a white collar boxing event and no written event plan was submitted 14 days prior to the event. You must read and be aware of all of your conditions and pre-emptive notice must be provided to Thames Valley Police and

West Berkshire Council in line with this condition. This condition was identified in your previous inspection in January 2018.

Door Supervisors page 10

Condition 3 – This condition was not complied with as there was no female door supervisor on duty. The DPS claimed he shared a female door supervisor with The Kennet Centre. They do employ a female who works on her days/evenings off as a door supervisor but doesn't provide door supervision support for The Vault whilst employed at The Kennet Centre. Police spoke to her and she confirmed that she had never covered whilst working at The Kennet Centre and in fact had been told by Robert Anderson that she would no longer be working for the Vault prior to Christmas 2018 and had not worked there since. She is unaware if he has employed any female since she left.

Public Safety page 12

Staff training and alcohol sales

This condition was not complied with and no training records were available to be shown during the inspection to provide any degree of due diligence in this area.

You are reminded that the people legally responsible for the premises under the Licensing Act 2003 are the premises licence holder and the designated premises supervisor.

With that in mind a performance meeting will be arranged to enable us to rectify our concerns over your non-compliance with your licence conditions, and overall general poor performance to date.

It is hoped that you will be able to provide sufficient evidence at this stage to show the required improvements that may negate further action.

We must inform you that this will be a formal process and you may wish to have a licensing legal advisor attend to provide you with advice if you feel that may be required.

We required you to attend this meeting on Friday the 22nd of February at 1000hours at Newbury Police Station, Mill Lane, Newbury, Berkshire, RG14 5QU.

In the meantime can you please ensure that all of the above points contained within this letter have been rectified, and an unannounced inspection during trading hours will be completed in the very near future to ensure that your licence is now in compliance and that your premises does not continue to undermine the licensing objectives
