1. Background

- 1.1 Members will be aware that annual Service Plans are a fundamental part of the Council's performance management framework. - 1.2 This year's Children & Young People Service Plan is divided into 4 parts. Part 2 is the Children & Young People Service Plan and looks at the national and local context affecting the work of the directorate and details the aims, priorities and supporting strategies the directorate needs to work on as a whole and in partnership with other agencies and organisations. Part 4 contains the appendices.
- 1.3 Eventually, Service Plans will state how we resource the priorities for the directorate over a 3-year period. However, at the time of writing the Council's medium term budget strategy is still in preparation. This Service Plan, therefore, will concentrate on 2004/2005. It will emphasise the importance of maintaining high quality universal services, whilst acknowledging where priorities or developments have to be resourced through reinvestment or the securing of external funding.
