

Summary of Individual Executive Member Decisions taken on 31 March 2005

Individual Decision No: ID0869

Portfolio Member: Councillor Sally Hannon – Highways and Transportation

40mph Speed Limit – A329 Wallingford Road, Streatley

Resolved that:

- (1) given the adverse response to the statutory consultation, an experimental 40mph speed limit be introduced for 18 months on the A329 Wallingford Road between its junction with the A417 Wantage Road and a location north of Townsend Road, as shown on the Plan No SLR/04/12 (Appendix C to the report);
 - (2) vehicle speeds be regularly monitored during the experimental period and a report prepared on the results towards the end of the experimental period to be considered by Individual Decision;
 - (3) junction improvements be introduced on the A329 Wallingford Road at its junction with Townsend Road as shown on plan no Plan No SLR/04/12/001 (Appendix D to the report);
 - (4) the respondents to the statutory consultation be informed accordingly.

Individual Decision No: ID0869

Portfolio Member: Councillor Sally Hannon – Highways and Transportation

Proposed Taxi Rank – High Street, Hungerford

Resolved that:

- (1) the location of the taxi rank and disabled bays be relocated as described in paragraph 4.2 of the report (see below) and included as part of any proposed measures from the Hungerford Parking Review. The implementation be jointly funded by West Berkshire Council and Hungerford Town Council.
“4.2 To address the objections raised it is possible to convert the existing disabled parking bay located underneath the railway bridge on the eastern side of the High Street to a taxi rank. However the disabled bays would need to be relocated and the most suitable location would be to convert a section of the parking area on the western side of the High Street underneath the railway bridge. Measures would be required to upgrade the road surface so that it is suitable for use by the disabled.”
 - (2) the objectors be informed accordingly.
