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## Supporting Information

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### 1. Background

- 1.1 A petition containing 83 signatures was presented by Councillor Graham Pask at the Council meeting on 3 March 2009. The petition states:
- “A petition to have the roads in and around Bucklebury Village completely resurfaced as the continued patching has proved to be ineffective”.*
- 1.2 The petition is generic and no specific sections of road have been identified that may be in need of repair
- 1.3 The road network serving the Parish of Bucklebury comprises: A Roads; B Roads; C Roads and U Roads.
- 1.4 Since 2002, the Council has been carrying out a comprehensive programme of annual testing to determine the condition of its highway network. The condition of the classified network (A, B and C roads) is measured using SCANNER (Surface Condition Assessment for the National Network of Roads) and was first used in 2003/04. The condition of the unclassified road network is measured using a nationally accepted survey methodology known as CVI (Course Visual Inspection).
- 1.5 Details of the survey methodology, survey coverage and the Council’s approach to highway asset management are described in the current Local Transport Plan.
- 1.6 The Council also carries out routine safety inspections. The frequency of inspection depends on the strategic importance of the road and type of traffic using it. In most cases, the rural network is inspected every 3 months and any defects found which exceed the set intervention levels are made safe within 2 hours.
- 1.7 For the 12 month period commencing 1 April 2008, the Council received 29 ELM reports of potholes, 11 ELM reports on road condition, 13 third party claims and 4 reported slight injury accidents on the road network serving the Parish of Bucklebury. ELM is the Streetcare database system for logging highway enquiries. With the exception of 1 injury due to black ice, no injuries relating to road condition were reported.
- 1.8 During the period 2006 to 2008, 11 roads were resurfaced within the Bucklebury area. These are summarised in Appendix A. An additional £18,000 was spent during 2008 on permanent patching repairs.
- 1.9 Within the Council’s recently approved 5 Year Highway Improvement Programme 2009 -13, a further 11 sections of road have been identified for resurfacing and these are summarised in Appendix B.

### 2. Conclusion

- 2.1 The survey condition data indicates that roads serving the Bucklebury area are generally in good condition and those that are in need of repair have been prioritised along with similar sections of road across the district and have been included within the current 5 Year Highway Improvement Programme.

- 2.2 The Council will continue to routinely inspect and survey the roads serving the Bucklebury area and carryout any necessary repairs or re-prioritisation of the programme to ensure that they remain in a safe condition.

### 3. Recommendations

3.1 In view of the above it is recommended that the Council:

- (a) continues to routinely inspect and survey the road network serving the Bucklebury area,
- (b) carries out the necessary repairs to ensure that the network remains in a safe condition,
- (c) reviews the 5 Year Highway Improvement Programme to reflect changes in condition,
- (d) Informs the petition organiser of the Council's recommendation.
