Looked briefly at the CoRE 11 Recommendations and free resources including

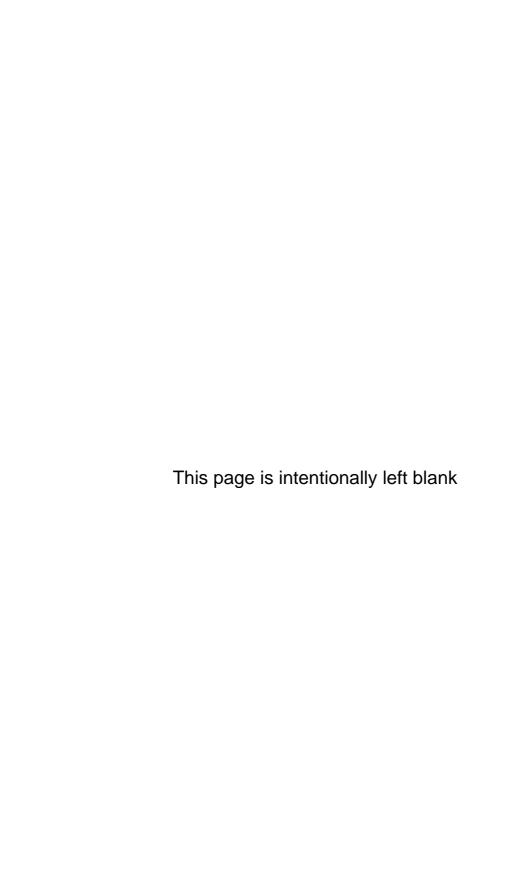
- RE Online new refreshed website being launched May/June 2019
