The report summarises the Newbury Town Centre Masterplan and Vision commissioned by the Council in 2020 and developed by a consultant team led by Hemingway in collaboration with residents, businesses and stakeholders.

The report outlines the next steps and potential risks associated with the delivery of the Masterplan by the Council in partnership with key stakeholders and seeks endorsement for taking the Masterplan forward.

The purpose of the report is to set out the financial planning assumptions for future years and align these with the Council Strategy to ensure that Council Strategy will be delivered. The MTFS highlights the overarching key issues facing the Council's finances as well as how there are many different scenarios and uncertainty concerning the future revenue streams for the Council in the future.

### 11. Capital Strategy, Financial Years 2022/23 to 2026/7 (C4126) Purpose:

The report outlines the Capital Strategy covering financial years 2022/23 – 2026/7 and the supporting funding framework, providing a high-level overview of how capital expenditure, capital financing and treasury management activity contribute to the provision of local public services along with an overview of how associated risk is managed and the implications for future financial sustainability.



#### 12. Revenue Budget 2022-23 (C4127)

347 - 446

Purpose:

The purpose of the report is to consider and recommend to Council the 2022-23 Revenue Budget, which proposes a Council Tax requirement of £110.1m, requiring a Council Tax increase of 1% and an Adult Social Care precept of 3%. The Council Tax will raise £1.1m and the precept will raise a further £3.2m. At 4%, the budget is balanced, after using £5m of reserves that have been specifically set aside. The overall Council Tax increase is intended to balance the financial impact of the pandemic on residents, mitigating the financial pressures they face, as well as the cost pressures that the Council faces.

The report also proposes the Fees and Charges for 2022-23 as set out in Appendix F and the Parish Expenses as set out in Appendix G and recommends the level of General Reserves as set out in Appendix E.
