#### 1. Purpose of the Report

1.1 To set out the background information pertaining to this Temporary Event Notice (TEN) Application.

#### 2. Recommendation

- 2.1 Members are asked to decide whether to:
  - a) ) Grant the notice as made;
  - b) Refuse the notice and issue a counter notice;
  - c) Grant the TEN subject to additional conditions.

Members of the Licensing Sub-Committee are asked to make a decision at the end of the hearing after all relevant parties have been given the opportunity to speak. Members must give full reasons for their decision.

#### 3. Background

- 3.1 Under the Licensing Act 2003 the chief officer of police and local authority function team in relation to minimising or preventing the risk of pollution of the environment or of harm to human health (EH) have the opportunity to consider whether they should object to a TEN on the basis it would undermine the relevant licensing objectives. Members of the Licensing Sub-Committee are asked to determine this application as the Licensing Authority has received representations from Russel Davidson on behalf of EH.
- 3.2 The objection states that granting this application would undermine the prevention of public nuisance. The objection makes reference to previous events in 2017 and 2018 following which complaints were received from surrounding neighbours (some over 500m away) alleging noise disturbance and music still continuing past the stipulated times. EH have concerns that no noise control measures have been proposed despite EH officers giving advice on previous events.

- 3.3 The Licensing Authority may only consider aspects relevant to the application that have been raised in these representations. Where representations have been received from a responsible authority and the concerns have not been resolved through mediation between all parties, the Licensing Act 2003 requires that these applications should be determined by the Licensing Authority's Licensing Committee. The Licensing Act 2003 allows for applications such as this one to be delegated to a Sub-Committee. In accordance with those rules, the Scheme of Delegation set out in the Council's Constitution states that the Licensing Sub-Committee has responsibility for dealing with these applications
- 3.4 The Licensing Authority had received an application, from Mr William Lovell, for a Temporary Event Notice in relation to Monksmead House, Woolhampton Hill, Upper Woolhampton, Reading, RG75TA. This application, received on the 03 March 2021 had been recorded under reference number 21/00135/LKB. A copy of the application is attached as Appendix 2.
- 3.5 A plan showing the location of the premises is attached at Appendix 1. The application is for a summer party to be held on the 04th and 05th September from 7pm to 4am. The premises is farmland (known as Big Park) and the woodland (known as Poppys). The application is for the sale by retail of alcohol, the provision of regulated entertainment and the provision of late night refreshment for a maximum number of 400 people at any one time on the premises. The sale by retail of alcohol is to be on the premises only and the provision of late night entertainment is to be between 6pm and 2.00am.
- 3.6 The applicant has confirmed that neither he nor any of his associates have been granted a temporary event notice in respect of any premises for events falling in the same calendar year as this event.

#### 4. Consultation

4.1 The notification was received on the 03 March 2021 and a representation was received from Environment Health on the 04 March 2021. The objection notice was therefore received within the prescribed three working days following the day on which the TEN application was received. In accordance with the regulations the licensing sub-committee must now consider the objection at a hearing before a counter notice can be issued. A copy of the representations are attached at Appendix 3.

Re: TENS application submitted by William Lovell

I have reviewed the above TENS application and write to confirm that I would like to raise an objection.

Previous events in 2017 and 2018 raised several complaints from surrounding neighbours (some over 500m away) alleging noise disturbance and music still continuing past the stipulated end-time. Complaints were also received by TVP.

The event takes place in a natural bowl which is supposed to reduce noise levels. Acoustically, this is simply not the case and with low background noise in this area noise will travel hundreds of metres. Live bands and DJs continuing to 4am will inevitably lead to further complaints if this event is permitted to take place. No noise control measures have been proposed despite EH officers giving advice on previous events.
