Item number 1 Ceiling and Wall Spread of Flame	
Outcome	This work is necessary to reduce the risk of the spread of fire.
Suggested Action	Either Receive and provide confirmation that decorative wall and ceiling linings present achieve the following surface spread of flame classifications as a minimum: Class 0 or B-s3, d2 for circulation spaces and escape routes. Class 1 or C-s3, d2 for any rooms not on escape routes. Class 3 or D-s3, d2 for use in rooms less than 30m².
Reason	Or Remove decorative wall and ceiling linings to ensure that any wall and ceiling linings achieve the surface spread of flame classifications listed above. Confirmation has not been received to indicate that decorative wall and ceiling linings present do not support the spread of fire. This could lead a fire spreading rapidly and make the escape route unsafe for people to use.

Item number 2 Fire Risk Assessment	
Outcome	This work is necessary to ensure that a Fire Risk Assessment is completed for the premises that this has considered all significant matters.
Suggested Action	A Fire Risk Assessment (FRA) should be completed for the premises and should consider but not be limited to the following matters: 1. The risk posed by wall and ceiling linings present. 2. The occupancy number and the exit & escape route capacity.
Reason	A Fire Risk Assessment for the premises has not been completed.
