You should declare your membership or position of general control or management of any body directed to charitable purposes: e.g. charities, charitable companies and trusts, industrial and provident societies.

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2. PRESSURE GROUPS

You should declare your membership or position of general control or management in any bodies one of whose principal purposes includes the influence of public opinion or policy (including any political party or trade union) e.g. - local action groups or societies.

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3. & 4. EMPLOYMENT, BUSINESS AND APPOINTMENTS

You should declare every employment or business carried on by you and any person or body who employs or has appointed you: this includes the name of any firm in which you are a partner and any company of which you are a paid director.

- Employees should give the name of their employer. If employed by a company, give the name of the company paying your wages or salary and not the ultimate holding company.
- Do **NOT** disclose details of salary.

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5. ELECTION EXPENSES

You should declare the name of any person or body (other than a relevant authority) that has made any payments to you in respect of your election or any expenses incurred by you in carrying out your duties. Relevant authorities include County, District and Parish Councils. You do not need to declare the amounts of any payments: only the name of the person or body making them.

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6. INTEREST IN COMPANIES AND SECURITIES

You should list the names of any person or body that have a place of business or land in the Parish and in whom you have a beneficial interest in a class of securities that exceeds the nominal value of £25,000 or 1/100th of the total issued share capital (which ever is the lower).

- You do not need to show the extent of your interest.
- Nominal value means the face value of the shares on the share certificate and not the market value.

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7. CONTRACTS WITH THE COUNCIL

You should declare any contracts for goods, services or works made between the Council and you or a firm in which you are a partner, a company of which you are a paid director or a person or body you have listed in section 6 above. You do not need to say what the financial arrangements are.

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GIFTS AND HOSPITALITY

You should declare details of any person from whom you have received a gift or hospitality with an estimated value of at least £25, within the last 3 years.

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LAND AND OWNERSHIP AND INTERESTS

- You should give the address or a brief description to identify it.

- 'land' includes any buildings or parts of buildings or open land.




