1. MEMBERSHIP OF OUTSIDE BODIES

You should declare your membership or position of general control or management in any bodies to which you are appointed or nominated by the Council.

You should declare your membership or position of general control or management of any body directed to charitable purposes, e.g. charities, charitable companies and trusts, CIOs, industrial and provident societies.

You should declare your membership or position of general control or management in any bodies of whose principal purposes includes the influence of public opinion or policy (including any political party or trade union), e.g. local action groups or societies.

- Do **NOT** disclose details of salary.

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5. ELECTION EXPENSES

You should declare the name of any person or body (other than a relevant authority) that has made any payments to you in respect of your election or any expenses incurred by you in carrying out your duties. Relevant authorities include County, District or Parish Councils. You do not need to declare the amounts of any payments, only the name of the person or body making them.

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6. INTERESTS IN COMPANIES OR SECURITIES

You should declare the name of any person or body that has a place of business or land in the parish and in whom you have a beneficial interest in a class of securities that exceeds the nominal value of £25,000 or 1/100th of the total issued share capital (whichever is the lower).

- N.B. You do not need to provide the extent of your interest.
- Nominal value means the face value means the face value of the shares on the share certificate, and not the market value.

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7. CONTRACTS WITH THE COUNCIL

You should declare any contracts for goods, services or works made between the Council and you, or a firm in which you are a partner, a company of which you are a paid director, or a body you have listed in section 6. You do not need to declare what the financial arrangements are.
