WEST BERKSHIRE DISTRICT COUNCIL in exercise of its powers under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 3(2) and 4(2), 19, 32, 35, 45, 46, 47, 49, 53, and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the 1984 Act") and all relevant powers under the Provisions of Part 6 of the Traffic Management Act 2004 and all enabling powers in accordance with the Local Authorities Traffic Orders (Procedure) (England and Wales) Regulations 1996 and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act **HEREBY MAKES** the following Order which amends and varies **WEST BERKSHIRE DISTRICT COUNCIL (PROHIBITION AND RESTRICTION OF WAITING AND LOADING, PARKING PLACES AND RESIDENTS' PARKING) (CONSOLIDATION) ORDER 2009** ("the Principal Order")

Commencement and Citation


1. This Amendment Order shall come into operation on the *[] day of [] 202[] and may be cited as the **WEST BERKSHIRE DISTRICT COUNCIL (PROHIBITION AND RESTRICTION OF WAITING AND LOADING, PARKING PLACES AND RESIDENTS' PARKING (CONSOLIDATION) ORDER 2009 (AMENDMENT NO 35) ORDER 202[]**
2. In this Amendment Order except where the context otherwise requires "the Principal Order" shall mean **WEST BERKSHIRE DISTRICT COUNCIL (PROHIBITION AND RESTRICTION OF WAITING AND LOADING, PARKING PLACES AND RESIDENTS' PARKING (CONSOLIDATION) ORDER 2009** (as amended)
3. Any reference in this Amendment Order to any enactment shall be construed as reference to that enactment as amended by any subsequent enactment
4. The Interpretation Act 1978 or any replacing Act shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of any Act of Parliament
5. Schedule 2 of the Principal Order is hereby amended by the revision of the following plans: **AK71** (Revision 8), **AK72** (Revision 7), **AR72** (Revision 2) **AS72** (Revision 2), **AT72** (Revision 5), **AU72** (Revision 2) and **AU73** (Revision 3)
6. The Principal Order as varied by this Order will in all other respects remain the same

Double yellow line restrictions to help ensure the on-carriageway cycle lane is not obstructed by parked vehicles and to encourage better and safer use of the facility.





OLD BATH ROAD, NEWBURY







NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that WEST BERKSHIRE DISTRICT COUNCIL PROPOSES to make the above Order the effect of which will be to further amend the WEST BERKSHIRE DISTRICT COUNCIL (PROHIBITION AND RESTRICTION OF WAITING AND LOADING, PARKING PLACES AND RESIDENTS' PARKING) (CONSOLIDATION) ORDER 2009 (as amended) ("the Principal Order") to the extent as set out below but in all other respect the Principal Order remains in force:

PLANS

The proposals will result in a change or addition of parking restrictions at the following locations:

Thatcham

A4 Bath Road –

- (i) (both sides) between the Thatcham Garden Centre entrance and Henwick Lane,
- (ii) (north side) fronting Nos 95-109,
- (iii) (both sides) between the western junction of St Johns Road and Green Lane
Beverley Close, Faircross Court, Northfield Road, St Johns Road and The Firs

Speen

Old Bath Road – (south side) between Speen Hill Close and Speen Lane

STATEMENT OF REASONS

This Order is proposed to revise existing parking restrictions and introduce additional parking restrictions on the A4 Bath Road in Thatcham and Old Bath Road in Speen to improve road safety. Specifically, the Order will address obstruction concerns related to inconsiderate parking along the route of the A4 Thatcham-Newbury and Old Bath Road cycleways. In addition, this Order will also address parking concerns at various locations identified on the associated plans and formalise parking restrictions on Northfield Road which were introduced on a temporary basis to resolve road safety concerns.

Accordingly, with reference to Section 1(1)(a) (c) and (f) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, this Order is necessary in order to:

1. Avoid danger to people and other road users / or for preventing the likelihood of danger
2. Facilitate passage on the road of other road users
3. Preserve or improve the amenities of the area
