I would like to raise a objection to the application for Variation to a Premises Licence at the Croft Hall Hungerford R17 0HY

There are already venues in the Croft area that provide ideal premises for outdoor events such as the Hungerford club and the Croft field which has been refurbished and has both indoor and outdoor facilities .

Parking is already a problem in the area with access often difficult due to poor parking and the fact that Parsonage Lane is a dead end .

The Croft Hall is well used for multiple functions and the inclusion for further use of the area at the rear of the Hall which may cause issues for neighbours seems unnecessary and seems to duplicate the functions already covered by the Hungerford club and the Croft field
