1. Health Scrutiny Panel

1.1 The Health Scrutiny Panel will be a Panel of the Overview and Scrutiny Management Commission.

2. Objectives

- 2.1 The Panel will have the following objectives which align broadly to the activities of the Healthier Sustainable Community Strategy theme, focussed on:
 - 1. reducing health inequality;
 - 2. improving the health and well-being of local people;
 - 3. ensuring children and young people can be healthy; and
 - 4. promoting the independence of vulnerable people.

3. Proposed Terms of Reference

- 3.1 Its terms of reference would be:
 - (i) To consider the way in which local healthcare services are commissioned and delivered; facilitate the health and well-being of the community of West Berkshire; contributes to health improvement; and reduce inequalities.
 - (ii) To ensure that the needs and wishes of all the population (including socially excluded groups) for health and health related services have been identified.
 - (iii) To ensure that all services which have an impact on the health of local people are accessible to, and can be accessed by, all parts of the local community.
 - (iv) To determine whether the outcomes of intervention are equally good for all groups and sections of the local population.
 - (v) To scrutinise any proposed significant changes to local health service provision and assess the impact of these on local people.
 - (vii) To seek and take account of the views of residents of West Berkshire and work with stakeholders and providers in formulating recommendations.
 - (viii) Monitoring, working with the local HealthWatch, the effectiveness of existing service provision, identify gaps and areas for improvement and development.
 - (ix) That appropriate recommendations from the Health Scrutiny Panel are referred to the Health and Wellbeing Board for consideration.
