



H The members for a Licensing Sub-Committee are identified by Officers based on availability following consultation with the Chairman of the Licensing Committee.

I The Chairman (or Vice Chairman if the Chairman is absent) of the Licensing Committee will chair a Licensing Sub Committee meeting if present.

J The Governance Committee membership is comprised of eight Councillors plus two Parish Council representatives

K The Advisory Panel membership comprises two Councillors from the Administration, two from the main opposition party, two Parish or Town Councillors and two (out of three) Independent Persons.

L There are no substitutes for Councillor members of the Advisory Panel, but there are two Parish Council member substitutes (and three Independent Persons, with two sitting on a Panel).

M Members for an Appeals Panel are identified by Officers based on availability.

N The Appeals Panel as a body does not have a Chairman - the Chairman for each Appeals Panel Meeting will be elected at the Meeting.

O The Joint Public Protection Committee comprises six members, two from each local authority (for WBC, the relevant Executive Member and the Chairman of the Licensing Committee, plus an Executive Member substitute) with the Chairmanship and Vice-Chairmanship rotating between the Executive membership.
